





Annexure

- State wise some important points to note from the ground -

Madhya Pradesh

- More people in rural areas feel that the Mahagathbandhan is just a unity of corrupt.
- PM Modi remains to be popular(>50%) in Women, and Youth, Senior citizens
- Anti-sentiment against PM Modi is more in the Muslims- youth and men alike, and also in middle-aged businessmen (belonging to small and medium businesses) that have suffered a fall in business activity post GST.
- There are two types of supporters of Mahagathbandhan 1. Muslims 2. Haters of Modi post GST and demonetisation. More than supporters of Mahagathbandhan they are individuals who're haters of Modi.
- In farmers the problem is with state specific policies not reaching them, for example "Bhavantar Yojana."
- Best quote " Jinki dukaan nahi chal rahi vo log sath aarahe hain".

Kerala

- State has roughly 50% minority population- Christian and Muslims. The CPM and Congress are main contenders in these communities. Minorities have more proclivities towards Congress than CPM, considering its diminishing role nationally.
- Out of 15% Hindu Population, BJP has 15% vote share among Nayar (forward caste) and Ereva (backward caste) and there is likelihood to increase this vote share.
- There will not be any formal Mahagathbandhan in the state.

Chhattisgarh

- 50% of educated Muslim youth feel Mahagathbandhan will not be good for India.
- Rahul Gandhi is the most popular Mahagathbandhan leader in the state

Karnataka

 The strength of JDS- Congress alliance in the state will play a major role in determining the national narrative of the Mahagathbandhan

Uttar Pradesh

• This is the state where more than 50% people believe that Mahagathbandhan will be a strong force in 2019.

Bihar

- Tejaswi Yadav is the most popular leader, after Nitish Kumar.
- Significant increase in acceptance of RJD in the voters.

Punjab

• This will be a triangular fight between Congress lead by Captain, Akali, and BJP on the ground. AAP is less relevant as a party of choice in voters.

Delhi

• This is the only state where Mahagathbandhan supporters proposed to project Arvind Kejriwal as PM face(40% of Gathbandhan supporters)

West Bengal

 More than 90% of Mahagathbandhan supporters want to see Mamata Banerjee as PM face, but 60% of these supporters admit that Gathbandhan will not last 5 years.

Haryana

 No other Mahagathbandhan leader apart from Rahul Gandhi finds acceptance in the State.

Rajasthan

• Irrespective of popular belief, the image of PM Modi has not tarnished or lost popular perception in the state. Anti-incumbency is state centric
